Department Activities







a) A good morning message has been writing on a blackboard and always by the Major -Part-I students, which is known as " USHA"(means Dawn) in the morning of every working day to purity the mind set of the student coming from different corners of the society from 2003.

(b) A Wall Magazine named as "RAMDHENU" has been published by the student on the department from 2003 under the supervision of the teachers.

(c) An Annual Journal "JAGRITI" has been publishing by the students under the supervision and financial aid of the department teachers from the years 2004.

(d) The department has establish a new platform for practice of literary work among students and teachers of the department namely "Asamiya Sahitya Chora" in the year 2003 .The HOD, Assamese sits on the chair and another teacher on secretarial office and all the other teachers and students are registered as member of the 'Chora'. The 'Chora takes necessary steps to publish the wall magazine and the Annual Journal in time.

e) The Assamese department has been organized A Social Day annually, named as 'Pragya Sandhani Divas (means Talent Search Day) since the year 2007 . The main goal of this programmed to searches the talent of new come through their creativity, extra ordinary internal qualities etc. The best newcomer gets the 'Pragya Sandhani Borta'. All the faculties of the College are invited to the meet, Scholars from outside the college also are invited to address the students. It will be worth mentioning here that, students bring different types of Assamese 'Pitha'(Cabes) and 'Laddus to (all are home made) serve the guest of the occasionIn the past few years, special lectures on language, literature and culture have been organized in conjunction with this program for the benefit of students











f) **Awards:** The department has introduced two awards in order to encourage the students of the department:

(1) Ghana Gogoi memorial award: This award consisting of Rs 10000/- and a running trophy goes to the student, who best Assamese Major graduate . It was started from the year 2004. The cost is borne by the family of Late Ghana Gogoi .

(2) Naina Mahanta Memorial Award : This award consisting of Rs. 5000/- and a packet of books, certificate goes to the best Assamese Major graduate with first class. It was introduced in the year 2009. The cost of the award is borne by the family of late Naina Mahanta .

g)**Seminar-Workshop**: Lectures, seminars, personality development workshops, creative writing workshops, research methodology workshops, workshops on various topics related to Indian knowledge system, career counseling etc. are conducted for the benefit of the students covering various curricular and extracurricular topics. The department organized webinar / Seminar/ Workshop / talk (2019-20 to-2023-24) as below:

1. An online webinar on 'সাম্প্রতিক প্রেক্ষাপটত অসমৰ পৰিৱেশ্য কলা' was held on 06-07-20. The resource person of the wwbinar was Dr. Pranjit Bora, Assistant Professor, Department of Assamese, Dibrugarh University.

2. On 29-07-2020, an online webinar entitled "অসমীয়া ভাষাৰ যুগ বিভাজনঃ পুনর্বিচাৰ" was held. The webinar was attended by Professor Subasana Mahant, Professor, Department of Assamese, Dibrugarh University as a resource person.

3. On 01-06-2022, the Department of Assamese organized an online national seminar entitled "'অসমীয়া ভাষাত মুক্ত শৈক্ষিক সমলঃ আহৰণ আৰু ব্যৱহাৰ". The seminar was attended by Dr. Swapna Bora, Assistant Professor, Teaching and Learning Centre, Tezpur University as a resource person.

4. A National Workshop on "প্ৰকল্প প্ৰস্তুতকৰণঃ পদ্ধতি আৰু কৌশল"was organized by the Department on 22-06-22. The workshop was attended by Dr. Pallavi Bora, Assistant Professor, Department of Folk Culture Studies, Guwahati University as a resource person.











5. The 22nd and 23rd October ,2022 ''অসমীয়া সাহিত্য বুৰঞ্জী আৰু সংস্কৃতিঃ অধ্যয়নৰ ভিন্ন মাত্ৰা'' was held. A total of 31 papers prepared individually and jointly by 62 students from various colleges of Assam were presented.

9. The National Seminar on '''শংকৰদেৱঃ সৃষ্টি আৰু দৰ্শন'' was held on 05-04-2024 in collaboration with Sri Manta Sankrdev Sngha Bhugbari Sakha.

10. Two career workshops were held on 03-05-2023 and 20-02-24 The workshops were organized by the Department of Assamese with the theme 'Assamese as a Career' and Assistant Professor of Assamese Department Dr. Ankur Dutta participated as the resource person The resource person Dr. Dutta said that the field of self-reliance in the future of the students studying Assamese as a special subject is not very smooth but he pointed out the possibilities in moving forward with new ideas

Publications: h) Departmental Apart from the departmental wall magazine 'Ramdhenu', magazine 'Jagriti', the departmental faculty members are involved in the editing of several important books. The books 'Bhasha Samikhan', 'Bismrita Boibhav'. Sahitva 'Patryapon', 'Anubudhan Abalukan Samikhan', 'Purbaranga' 'Gargaon'etc. were published in collaboration with the departmental Faculties.









i) **Important Days Observation:** The department celebrates various days related to language, literature and culture like Laxminath Bezbarua's Birthday, Dr Bhupen Hazarika's Birthday, Bishnu Rava Day, Artist's Day, Mother Tongue Day, Language Day, Bihu, International Indigenous Day etc.

j) **Parent-Teacher Meet.** Two parent-teacher meet. ' are held in each academic year involving the parents of the students of all three semesters of the department with the aim of strengthening the relationship between teachers, students and parents. The event also raised awareness about the care to be taken of the student in the home environment, the responsibilities and duties of parents towards the department and college and also formed a teacher-parent committee for a one-year term. The Teacher-Parent Conferences (October 28, 2019, October 9, 2020, February 17, 2022, November 4, 2023, March 16, 2024) have been held in the past five years.
