Anannya Dasgupta

- When do we look “closely” at text (physically speaking)?
- Doing so involves
 - Slowing down
 - Care
 - Attention
 - Thoughtfulness
 - Considering context
 - Weighing probabilities
- Literary close reading involves all of these as well as attention to literary form, implications and nuances – that which is less obvious, that which is beneath the surface.
