


Restricted entry of automobiles

Biogas Plant at campus

Gargaon College embraces and deeply focuses for sustainable waste management and renewable energy solutions. The vision for establishing a biogas plant at Gargaon College is on process. The biogas plant is envisioned as a sustainable and environmentally friendly initiative to manage organic waste and generate renewable energy. Renewable energy produced by biogas facilities for both residential and commercial usage. Our reliance on fossil fuel energy may be lessened by storing this energy or putting it into the electrical grid, which will lessen our carbon impact. A biogas plant will aid in the fight against global warming. Greenhouse gas emissions would decrease if energy generated from fossil fuels is used less often by industrial and residential consumers.







Vermicompost and Leaf compost unit

Gargaon college has several Vermicompost and leaf compost unit inside the campus. The college faculties and staff give special emphasis on the use of biofertilizers instead the use of chemical fertilizers. These biofertilizers are used in gardening purpose and in organic garden also.

Solar Energy

Gargaon College is committed to using renewable energy sources to reduce its electricity consumption. The college has installed several solar streetlamps on campus to provide clean and green lighting. The college has also installed a set of solar panels to supply electricity to the Girls common room and nearby departments. The use of solar energy not only minimizes the college's environmental impact but also generates long-term financial savings.

Medicinal Herb diversity

In addition to this, Gargaon College maintains a medicinal herb garden in which different varieties of medicinal plants are planted. The plant species which are medicinally important are collected from different places, planted and maintained well in Gargaon College campus.

Rainwater Harvesting unit

The College maintains rainwater harvesting units at different sites in the campus. At present there are four rainwater harvesting units installed which are in proper working conditions. 

NOTICE

Policy on Restricted Entry of Vehicles in the College Campus

- Students' vehicles shall be allowed only up to the designated parking area. Entry beyond
 that point is strictly prohibited.
- 2. No student shall be permitted to enter the campus with four wheelers.
- Vehicles must be parked only in the allotted slots.
- 4. No student shall be permitted to park their bike near the playground.
- 5. Entry of two wheelers inside the playground is strictly prohibited.
- No students shall be allowed to bring a two wheeler above 350 cc inside the college campus.
- 7. Vehicle speed shall be limited to 10 Km/hr inside the college campus.
- All motor vehicle rules which are enforced by the road transport authority shall be applicable inside the college campus.
- Students are strictly advised to use public transport/bicycles for commuting to college to promote the green initiatives of the college.
- 10. Any violation of these rules shall lead to revoking of parking permit.

Policy for ban on single use of plastic inside the Gargaon college campus

As per the order from Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, implementation of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 has been enforced in the college for the past five years.

The following rules need to be followed strictly inside the college campus-

- 1. Single use plastic items are banned inside the college premises.
- 2. Complete ban on use of plastic carry bags inside the college campus.
- 3. Banners, buntins, cups, cling films, flex, flags, and plates including the above items made of thermocol and plastic which use plastic micro beads are banned.
- 4. Students and faculty members are encouraged to bring their own water bottles to discourage the use of plastic bottles.
- 5. Canteen staffs are encouraged to utilize the reusable cups, plates, dishes and anything not made from plastic.
- 6. Use of plastic film to pack or cover any book including magazine or invitation card is completely banned.

Gargaon College Policy for Preventing Noise Pollution in the College Campus

The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines and procedures to prevent noise pollution in the college campus, ensuring a peaceful and conducive learning and living environment for all members of the college community. This policy applies to all students, faculty, staff, visitors, and any other individuals in the campus.

Guidelines:

- 1. Noise-Free Zones: Gargaon College Library, Classrooms (Room no 3-14), Biotech Hub, Golden Jubilee Hall has been designated as "Noise-Free Zones", where noise levels should be kept to a minimum. Area around Girls and Boys Hostel have been designated as "No horn" zones. Any noise within these zones, prohibiting any activities that disrupt the quiet and concentration of others, will be strictly dealt with.
- Quiet Hours: Hours from 9 am to 11 am are designated quiet hours every-day during the ongoing session. Noise levels should be significantly reduced in all areas of the campus during sessional and end-semester examinations Specific quiet hours and any exceptions to it would be communicated to the entire college community. Quiet hours policy would be enforced through regular monitoring and appropriate disciplinary actions for non-compliance.
- Noise-Producing Activities: Noise-producing activities in campus, such as construction
 work, maintenance activities, and equipment operation, will be regulated within specific
 timeframes and designated areas to minimize disruptions. Contractors, vendors, and

service providers working in campus must adhere to noise regulations and minimize the noise impact.

- 4. Compliance and Disciplinary Actions: Progressive disciplinary action would be taken against offenders that may include warning, Monetary fines, confiscation of noisecreating equipment, and in more serious cases or persistent violations, legal action may be taken against the offender.
- 5. Ongoing Evaluation: We at Gargaon college, regularly assess the effectiveness of the noise pollution prevention measures and policies in the campus and periodically seek feedback from the college community through surveys, focus groups, or other means to identify areas for improvement, so as to make necessary adjustments to the policy based on feedback and evolving needs.

Implementation: The college administration, in collaboration with the stakeholders, shall be responsible for the implementation, enforcement, and periodic review of this policy. The policy shall be communicated to all members of the college community through appropriate channels.

Adherence to this policy is crucial in maintaining a harmonious campus environment that fosters learning, concentration, and overall well-being for everyone.




