#### Rationality

The NEP 2020 paves the way towards less regulation and more autonomy for institutions through an effective self-regulatory framework. The NEP 2020 heralds the of vocational education in the country potentially explosive growth. Focus is laid for vocational exposure of the learners through school and higher education.

Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta, Principal of Gargaon College in his welcome address highlighted on NEP, 2020 stating that as per the New Education policy, is to combine the traditional knowledge with modern thinking. The Seminar, he said that would look into the issues and policies related to the implementation of the integration of vocational education into mainstream education and also in higher educational institution.

Prof. Deb Kumar Chakraborty inaugurated the Seminar. In his inaugural speech, Prof. Chakraborty said that we are passing through a very difficult phase in the global pandemic situation which has not only affected the economic growth but also the educational fields. He highlighted on the importance of vocational courses and skill formation.

Prof. Hiranya Nath was invited to deliver the keynote address of the seminar. Prof. Nath focused on the economic context in the educational policy. He talked about vocational education and the larger context of economic changes. He also discussed about the challenges and opportunities for introducing vocational courses in higher education institution. NEP re imagines by giving importance on focus areas based on skill gap analysis and mapping local opportunities. Speaking about the challenges and opportunities he pointed out the possible challenges as society's perception, mismatch, and shortage of qualified teachers/trainers keeping up with the rapid changes in the economy. While referring to the opportunity, he mentioned about the health and human services, health care and personal care, increased interactions with industries, early adopter advantage.

Dr. Anup Kumar Das from Rajib Gandhi University, Arunachal University presented the lead paper of the Seminar. The topic of his presentation was Skill Development in India: Its Importance, Extent and Impact on Employment. He started his deliberation stating that human capital plays a crucial role. Human capital, he said often used by economist for education, health and other human capacities that can raise productivity. In the course of his deliberation, Dr. Das also spoke about the




skill development in India and job-oriented education provided through vocational training and other higher education institutes. In his closing remark, he pointed to the factors affecting the participation in skill development trainings in the study area he conducted. He concluded his speech by saying that Skill development is viatl for economic development especially in a country like India.

The first technical Session was chaired by Prof. Deb Kumar Chakraborty, Dibrugarh University. The Resource person of the first technical session was Dr. Sumin Prakash, Assistant Professor, Rajib Gandhi University. Dr. Prakash said that atleast one student should be exposed to vocational education. He further pointed that they should be exposed to real skilled based courses. He talked about the various courses that are categorized under vocational courses. He also mentioned about the vocational courses offered by Govt. of India. About collaboration, he said that minimum ten days workshops can be organized in collaboration with local vocational experts.

Several papers were presented in the technical session. In the valedictory function, the invited guests and resource person shared their views and opinions about the Seminar and their experience. Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta thanked all the participants and the Resource persons for their participation and making the seminar fruitful. The Two-day seminar ended with vote of thanks offered by Mr. Yuvaraj Gogoi, Assistant Professor of the Department of Political Science, Gargaon College.




#### Rationality



#### Rationality

Suicide is closely linked with mental health. Causes of suicidal tendencies among youth is increasing day by day. Suicidal thoughts are common among teens and young adults and the numbers of such cases are really frightening. The present situation is not encouraging at all. Mental crisis, uncertainity of future, economic crisis are some of the common reasons for which the youths suffer from stress and anxiety. Proper counselling and motivation can go a long way in building up the mental wellbeing of the youths to face the challenge of time.

A National webinar was organized on the topic Youth, Mental Health and Suicide on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2020. The Resource person invited on the occasion was Dr. Sandipan Sharma. MD. Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta an eminent academic and Principal of Gargaon College in his inaugural address spoke about the stress and anxiety by the youths in the global pandemic situation. He said that youth is an important phase of the formative period and it has a major impact on future. It is the formative period that care has to be taken in building various factors like psychological, mental, physical wellbeing. In the process of climbing the ladder of success some become unsuccessful and they suffer from anxiety and stress. When they fear to tackle their problem, they commit suicide. Suicide, Dr. Mahanta said has been increasing day by day. The present situation is not encouraging at all, he added. He urged the students to become Physically active and to build up the mental well-being to face the challenge of the present situation.

Dr. Sandipan Sharma started his deliberation by referring to WHO and said that health is a complete state of complete physical, mental and social wellbeing. He focused on why mental health is important for all. Mr. Sharma said that suicidal thought and tendencies mostly occurs from depression and frustration. 


#### Rationality

Alcohol is one of the most widely used drug substances in the world. Alcohol is a toxic and psychoactive substance with dependence producing properties. Excessive alcohol use can lead to increased risk of health problems such as injuries, violence, liver diseases and cancer. The talk on Chemistry of Alcohol: Weighing Risks and Benefits was organized to aware the risk factors of excessive consumption of alcohol and health consequences.

The Department of Chemistry, Gargaon College, organized a Popular Talk on Chemistry of Alcohol: Weighing Risks and Benefits on the 10<sup>th</sup> of June, 2021. Dr. Ramesh Chandra Deka of Tezpur University was invited as a Resource person to deliver a talk on the topic. Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta, noted columnist and Principal of Gargaon College inaugurated the Popular talk. In his inaugural speech, Dr. Mahanta said that organizing such a talk on the topic would be beneficial to both the participants and research scholars. He appreciated the initiative of the faculty members of the department for organizing a talk on such a relevant issue.

Dr. Ramesh Chandra Deka, discussed on Alcohol Metabolism. He spoke about genetic factor and environmental factors of Alcohol (Ethanol) Metabolism. Speaking about the different enzymes which the body uses to metabolize alcohol, he pointed to four enzymes such as Alcohol dehydrogenase (ADH), Cytochrome P450 (CYP2E1), Catalase and Aldehyde dehydrogenase (ALDH). Some alcohol metabolism also occurs in other tissues, including the pancreas and the brain he said. Talking about the consequences of health, Dr. Deka said that there may be Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder if the alcohol consumption is greater. The consequences of alcohol metabolism include oxygen deficits (i.e., hypoxia) in the liver: interaction between alcohol metabolism byproducts and other cell components, resulting in the formation of harmful compounds (i.e., adducts), formation of highly reactive oxygen-



containing molecules (i.e., reactive oxygen species (ROS) that can damage other cell components; changes in the ratio of NADH to NAD.



#### Rationality

The discourse of nationalism in India has been mostly forwarded from state centric perspective. The themes of North East and Gender are found missing from such narratives. The webinar on Nationalism and Gender in the context of India's North East was organized to explore the issues related to Gender in the North East Perspective.

The welcome address of the National webinar was delivered by Dr. Ramananda Das, Head and Associate Professor of the Department of Political Science, Gargaon College. Nation is a state of construction, said the Resource person, Dr. Dolly Phukan while defining Nation. Nationalist discourses tend to create a nation. In the course of her deliberation, she spoke about the examples of Gendering the Nation. She said that imaginary is visible in much ethnography and in the political subnationalist slogans. The northeastern region is a heterogeneous region accommodating diverse cultures, language, and ethnicity and so on. Dr. Phukan said that it is difficult to address the gender dimensions keeping in view the vast diversities which also make the gender issues and implementations varied in nature. The gendered discourses and nationalism and sub-nationalism has put women's question in the margins. Yet the innumerable narratives of women and their contribution in the nation-building project cannot be denied. Literatures on women's quest for their identities, quest for peace and protection of their community is silent due to the masculinity histographies. Dr. Phukan said that there is a need to obliterate this stillness and actions should be taken to record and preserve these narratives of women which can be an alternative or counter to the patriarchal narratives. The National Webinar was coordinated by Dr. Pobon Kumar Gogoi, Associate Professor and the vote of thanks was offered by Mr. Yuvaraj Gogoi, Assistant Professor of the Department of Political Science, Gargaon College.
