Dr. Mahanta said that our Honorable Prime Minister Narendra Modihas delivered a speech on General Assembly, United Nations on 6th Sept, 2014 explaining the importance of Yoga. And United Nations General Assembly,2015 has decided to celebrate 21th June as International Yoga Day 2015. Yoga is the way of life. The art of practicing Yoga helps us in controlling our mind, body and soul. Yoga is the only way to keep us fit, he said. It is a key to keep our mind cool. Bishnu Rabha Divas

Resource Person – Hemraj Rabha

The Webinar was inaugurated by Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta, Principal, Gargaon College. Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta in his inaugural speech, spoke about Bishnu Rabha, a living embodiment of cultural diversity of Assam. Throwing light on the cultural figure of Assam, he said that Bishnu Rabha was a multifaceted artist and revolutionary singer of Assam. Apart from a singer, he was a poet, actor, dancer actor, music composer, playwright and a great artist. Dr.Mahanta also pointed



about the active role played by Bishnu Rabha in the freedom struggle movement. He also mentioned about the contribution of the legendary figure to the cultural life of Assam. Went to Kashi for showcasing Kamrupi dance and to research classical music. He said that Rabha was praised by Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, (Vice Chancellor) for his performance of dance based on Krishna Leela, Dasavatar and Tandava in Kashi. Further he pointed that Bishnu Rabha With his artistic and revolutionary concern, he dreamt of an egalitarian Assam. In his speech, Dr. Mahanta said that Bishnuprasad Rabha idealized Rupkonwar Jyotiprasad Agarwala and believed communalism as the way to ensure freedom. In his quest to bring true freedom for the people, had taken up arms gaining enormous popularity as a revolutionary artist. Dr. Mahanta urged the students to know about Rabha and make the best sense of Rabha and his ideology. He appreciated the imitativeness of the organizers for organizing such a webinar on the death anniversary of the cultural icon, Bishnu Rabha.

The Resource person, Mr. Hemraj Rabha spoke about the significance of the day. The speaker said that every year on his death anniversary, that is 20th June, the day is celebrated as 'Rabha Divas'. He praised the good practice of the people saying that everyone remembers his talent as an artist. Singer, lyricist, actor, music composer actor. He highlighted on the contribution of the cultural icon of Assam to different fields. Bishnu Rabha, has actively participated in the political field and was a staunch Marxist. He said creativity is the chief aim of the legend. His interest was laid on research. His songs are romantic, patriotic, religious and wrote children's song. He used very simple language in his compositions so that the very simple people like farmers can understand his songs, he said. Bishnu Rabha, he added was an idealist. His compositions and articles reflected his utmost devotion towards Sankardeva and he believed that society can achieve peace and prosperity through Sankardeva's teaching and neo-vaishnavism. He ended his speech by stating that through his contributions to art and cultural field, he has rightfully kept the Assamese society consciousness illuminated.

On the occasion of the Bishnu Rabha Divas, Songs and instrumental music were virtually performed by the invited guests in the same platform. The webinar ended with the vote of thanks offered by Mr. Pranob Duwarah, Assistant Professor of Assamese Department, Gargaon College.
