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## ABOUT THE COLLEGE

One of the oldest and illustrious institutions of higher education in Assam, Gargaon College was established on 7th September 1959. With a commitment to achieve excellence in higher learning, the college has been working relentlessly for the development of the learner as well as the furtherance of social good. Dr Harendra Nath Phukan was the founder Principal of the college. The college came under the deficitgrants-in-aid system of Government of Assam in the year 1966 and had also been included under section 12 (B) and 2 (f) of UGC Act 1956 under the affiliation of Dibrugarh University. Subsequently, the college was provincialized in 1966 under the leadership of Tanu Konger, the first permanent Principal of this institution.

Located in the heart of Gargaon, the college is fourteen kilometers to the east of Sivasagar town and well connected by road and rail. The Simaluguri Railway Station lies at a distance of 2.2 kilometers from the college premises. The college has a vast green campus set in peaceful surroundings. Its verdant setting makes it an exclusive destination from the environmental and ecological point of view. About 33 numbers of bird diversity, 32 numbers of fish diversity and more than two hundred varieties of medicinal plants have been identified at the college campus. The college has also initiated an organic garden and a vermicompost project for promoting sustainable agricultural practices in the campus.

From the historical standpoint, Gargaon was the capital of the Ahom Kingdom from 1539 A.D. to 1695 A.D. During this prolonged period, 15 successive kings were crowned on the throne beginning from Siu-Klen-Miung alias Gargaya Raja to Siu-Pat Pha alias Gadadhar Singha. The Kareng Ghar, the seven storied Royal Palace of the



Ahom kings, is situated within Gargaon. In addition to this, several unique and ancient monuments have been found in the environs of Gargaon that still resonate the glory of the Ahom Kings and Assamese people of yore.

The College currently provides both Higher Secondary and Three-Year Bachelor's Degree (Major and Pass Course) courses to more than two thousand students every academic year. The College has three faculties - Arts, Science and Commerce spread over seventeen departments, viz. Assamese, Botany, Chemistry, Commerce, Economics, Education, English, Geography, Geology, History,

Mathematics, Physics, Political Science, Rural Development, Sociology, Statistics and Zoology. The curriculum followed by the College at the Degree level is the one prescribed by Dibrugarh University. For Higher Secondary (viz, Arts, Science and Commerce), the syllabus and curriculum followed is the one prescribed by the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council. Apart from this, the college also provides a one year Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications (*PGDCA*).

In tune with its mission of delivering quality education, the college is always open to introducing new subjects and courses for the benefit of the student community. In this direction, the college, besides its regular courses, has taken the initiative to introduce a select list of Certificate, Diploma and Vocational programmes, too. Moreover, the college, under the aegis of its career counselling and guidance cell, offers career counselling and organizes different training programmes to orient its students towards the choice of an appropriate career on the basis of their skills, weaknesses, aptitudes and strengths.

Since its establishment, the college under the adroit and pioneering guardianship of eminent educationists and teachers has been successfully fulfilling the emerging needs and challenges of the times. In fact, it has been persistently trying to improvise



its knowledge delivery mechanism and infrastructure. The College was assessed and accredited by the *National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC)* for the first time in the year 2004. It was re-accredited for the second time in the year 2010. Most recently NAAC re-accredited the college with 'B-Grade' in the year 2019.

The college is committed towards growing into a center of excellence and sustaining its historical legacy to be the best by catering to all the needs of the learners, particularly those belonging to the weaker sections of the society. With such an aim in mind, the college has adopted a *Scheduled Castes* (SC) dominated village named Darika Kaibatra Gaon as a model village for the upliftment of its people in the area of education, health, etc.

Considering the social and economic backwardness of the region, Gargaon College has taken the onus of enlightening and edifying the minds of its students so that they can become exemplary citizens and contribute to the betterment of the society.

In his inaugural speech, Dr.Mahanta reflected on the gender issues throeing much light on the changing status of women in present times. The Webinar was graced by the virtual participation of three eminentspeakers, Dr. Upasana Mahanta, Professor and Director of Jindal Global University, Delhi, Dr. Dipti Visuddhangkoon, Associate Professor of Foreign Language of Mahachulalongkornrajavidyalaya, Thailand and Dr. Hemjyoti Medhi, Assistant Professor of English, Tezpur Central University. Dr. Upasana Mahanta spoke about the trends and trajectories of Women's movement where she highlighted on theissues and the problems affecting women in Indian context. The next speaker, Dr. Dipti Vishuddhangkoon highlighted on a different angle of looking at feminism by throwing light on Buddhist feminism wheras, Dr. Hemjyoti Medhi of Tezpur Central University talked about Women and the making of public sphere in Contemporary Assam. ## Line of Amity: An Eye to India – China Boundary Resolution 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 Organized by the Department of Political Science in collaboration with Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Gargaon College Resource Person – Dr. Jaideep Saikia, Eminent Author and Security Analyst Author & Security Analyst

Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta, noted columnist and Principal of Gargaon College, delivered the welcome address of the Webinar. In his welcome address, highlighting the glorious journey of the institution he said that Gargaon college is one of the premier institutions of higher seat of learning in Upper Assam. He praised the organizer and the faculty members of department of Political Science for organizing a webinar on such a relevant topic on contemporary time. He added that such a topic would be beneficial to the students and participants to share their views and to enlighten on such a complex issue. He thanked the participants and research scholars for their active participation in the webinar and he hoped that their participation would definitely help in making the discussion fruitful. The webinar was coordinated by Mr. Yuvaraj Gogoi, Assistant Professor of Political Science Department. He gave a brief introduction and achievement of the Resource Person, invited on the occasion. Dr. Jaydeep Saikia, eminent author and security analyst spoke on the topic and illuminated with his thought provoking speech on Line of Amity, the frame of the webinar. While throwing light on the topic, he mentioned about China's military doctrine. Line of amity is included in the eastern part of China, he said. He spoke about warfare under modern conditions from Mao's People War. The Chinese aggression was a manifestation of Chinese defense. He considered it unfortunate boarder war. He added that India underestimated Chinese military strength and embarked on 'Forward Policy'. Dr. Saikia said that Nehru attempted to raise the MML issue to a legal level whereas a political solution was pragmatic. He further stated that credible forces-i-being should precede meaningful dialogue. That's why he felt that the war is ongoing. China, he said wanted to teach India a lesson. Forward policy that India has embarked on, has instill a feeling of teaching a lesson to India by China. He talked about non-delineation of LAC facilitating claims over Arunachal Pradesh despite CBMs. They fear about another forward policy or posturing for negotiations. Tibet



Autonomous region has nuclearized. He talked about dragon footprints. Summing up, he said that protracted negotiations has not made headway. Non-resolution has increased mistrust, skirmishes and standoffs. He also pointed that there is inability to solve the I-C Boundary eluding common idiom and the status quo expressing itself in increasing bilateral hostility. He felt that Line of Amity is a viable option under the circumstances. We are not going to give an inches of land, he said. He ended his speech by saying that Line of Amity is the only opening gambit in the horizon.

The webinar came to an end with the vote of thanks offered by Dr. Pobon Gogoi, Head and Associate Professor of the Department of Political Science, Gargaon College.

The webinar was organized by the IQAC College to discuss about the SOP regarding the guidelines to appear in the examination of 6<sup>th</sup> Semester B.A/BSc/B.Com Examination, 2020 in online mode. The virtual programme was organized to clear the confusions of the candidates about the procedure of online submission of the answer scripts in google classroom and offline submission and other rules associated with the examination system as framed by the Dibrugarh University. Mr. Nilutpal Chutia read out the guidelines of Dibrugarh University and discussed all the points elaborately. He guided the students how to select the questions according to the marks of the question paper. He also discussed about the time allotment for full paper and half paper. Mr. Chutia asked the students to scan the answers scripts very carefully before uploading the files in pdf in own login ID. Dr. Surajit Saikia said that the students should select a very convenient app for clear and easy scanning of the papers. Mr. Chutia said that the students should use only black pen in answering the questions. The



time limit for uploading the pdf file is thirty mins and after that no PDF will be accepted after thirty mins. After the successful submission of the pdf, the students will receive a message of successful uploading. The file name, he said should be in the registration no of the students.

The students according to the guideline should submit the hardcopy to the college within thirty mins. If a student is unable to submit to his/her college who stays in long distance in that situation he/she can submit it to the nearest examination center with sealed envelope. It is important to note that once registered in offline, they cannot appear online or change his mode of submission. Many students raised their queries and cleared their confusions which was cleared by the speaker.
