### **Rationality of the program**

Wetland as vital source of life and livelihood and a very important ecosystem. The functions of wetland make them valuable ecosystems and integral part of economy of society. In recent times there has been extensive loss of wetlands in India including Assam. Increased anthropogenic pressure in terms of expansion of cities, conversion of rural to urban areas and extension of agricultural practices to attain food security have caused significant landuse/landcover changes thereby catalyzing loss of wetland. Hence, it is of paramount importance to monitor landuse/landcover changes on a temporal scale to identify and delineate the factors of wetland loss and understand there impacts on the wetland ecology. Quality of water of a wetland is the key to determine the fate of nearby Parameters such as pH, nutrient concentration, dissolved solids, turbidity, dissolve oxygen (DO), etc. of the wetland gives idea about the suitability and quality of water to support aquatic life, livelihood and sustainability. Assam is blessed to have innumerable wetlands of different denominations thus creating an ideal scenario for conservation and harnessing of healthy life.

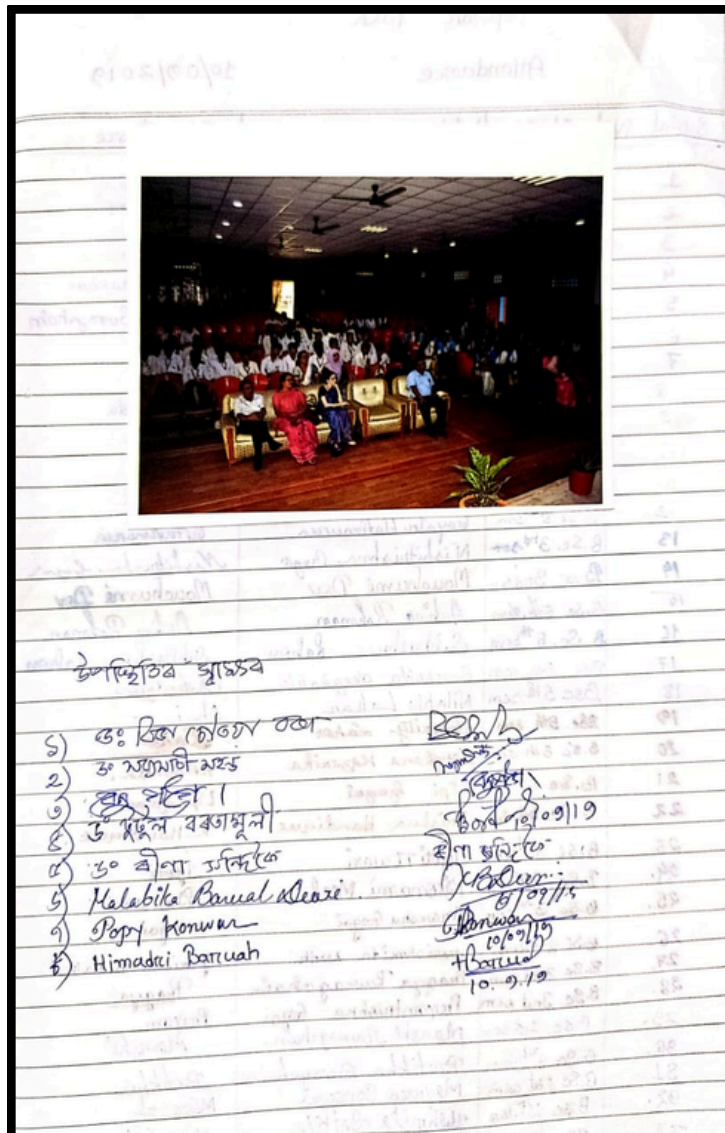
