BRIEF INTRODUCTION OF THE COLLEGE

Gargaon College, established on 7th September 1959 is one of the oldest and illustrious institutions of higher education in Assam. With a commitment to achieve excellence in higher education, the college has been working relentlessly for the development of the learner as well as the furtherance of social good. Dr Harendra Nath Phukan was the founder Principal of the college. The college came under the deficit-grants-in-aid system of Government of Assam in the year 1966 and is included under section 12 (B) and 2 (f) of UGC Act 1956 under the affiliation of Dibrugarh University. Subsequently, the college was provincialized in 1966 under the leadership of Tanu Konger, the first permanent Principal of this institution.

Located in the heart of Gargaon, the college is fourteen kilometers to the east of Sivasagar town and well connected by road and rail. The college has a vast green campus with about 33 numbers of bird diversity, 32 numbers of fish diversity and more than two hundred varieties of medicinal plants. The college has also initiated an organic garden, vermicompost project, plastic bottle bank among other endeavors for promoting sustainable agricultural practices in the campus.

From the historical standpoint, Gargaon was the capital of the Ahom Kingdom from 1539 A.D. to 1695 A.D. The Kareng Ghar, the seven storied Royal Palace of the Ahom kings, is situated within Gargaon, resonating the glory of the Ahom Kings and Assamese people of yore.

Gargaon College has been persistently trying to improvise its knowledge delivery mechanism and infrastructure. The College was assessed and accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) for the first time in the year 2004. It was re-accredited for the second time in the year 2010. In the year 2019, the college completed its third cycle of the NAAC Assessment.





The College currently provides Post Graduate, Three-Year Bachelor's Degree (Major and Pass Course) courses and Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) to more than two thousand students every academic year. The College has three faculties - Arts, Science and Commerce spread over seventeen departments.

Besides its regular courses, the college also provides a one year Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications (PGDCA). It has also taken the initiative to introduce a select list of Add On courses and vocational programmes along with B.Ed course in keeping with the objectives of NEP, 2020. Through various programmes conducted by its career counseling and guidance cell, the college has been able to guide and orient several meritorious and economically weak students towards successful careers in civil services and other competitive examinations.

In tune with its mission of delivering quality education and making the teaching learning process more effective, the College has created Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Assam Agricultural University, Teaching Learning Centre, Tezpur University and also with international institutions and organizations of repute.

An e-learning platform named as E-Shiksha has also been launched by the college which incorporates educational videos based on the curricula prepared by the faculty and facilitates online learning and access of its resources by the students anytime and from anywhere.

Moreover, the college has its own YouTube channel which broadcasts special lectures and talks on relevant issues from time to time. Besides, several faculty members have their own YouTube channels delivering well-designed learning content for the benefit of the student fraternity. The college tries to provide impetus to research activity among students and teachers. Along with several student projects, the faculty members are engaged in both major and minor research projects sponsored by ICSSR, ICHR etc.





The college is committed towards growing into a center of excellence and sustaining its historical legacy to be the best by catering to all the needs of the learners and is well-equipped to face the emerging needs and challenges of the times. Considering the social and economic backwardness of the region, Gargaon College has taken the onus of enlightening and edifying the minds of its students so that they can become exemplary citizens and contribute to the betterment of the society.




