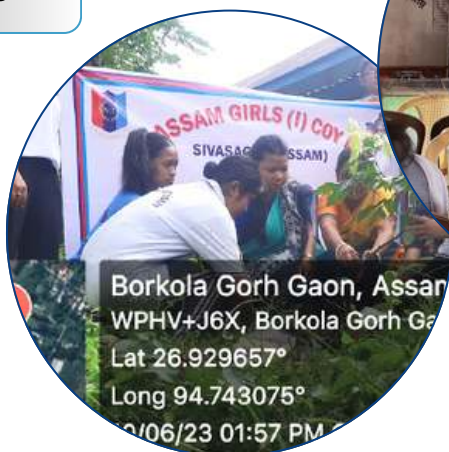

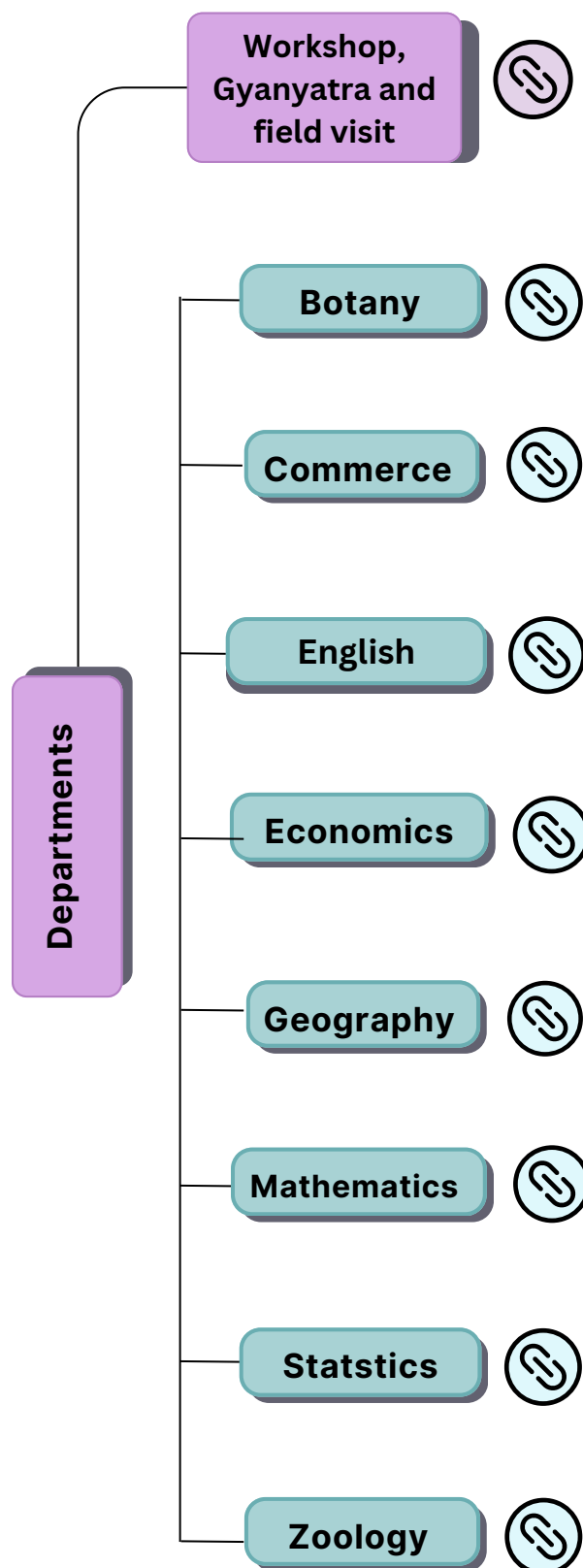
## Departmental Programmes

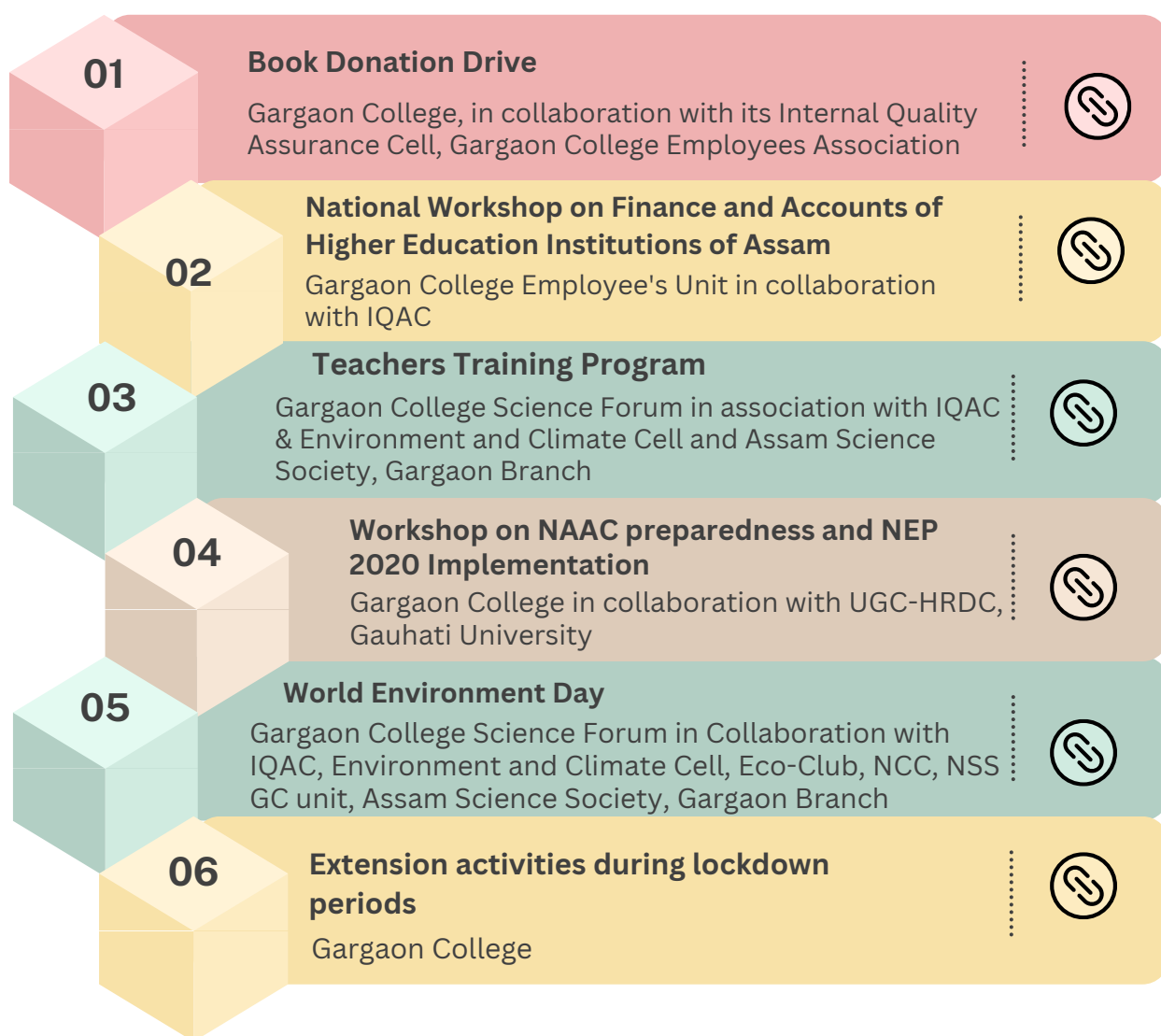
