3. After completion of the Sessional examination their performance were evaluated and provide positive feedback are provided to improve their academic performance.

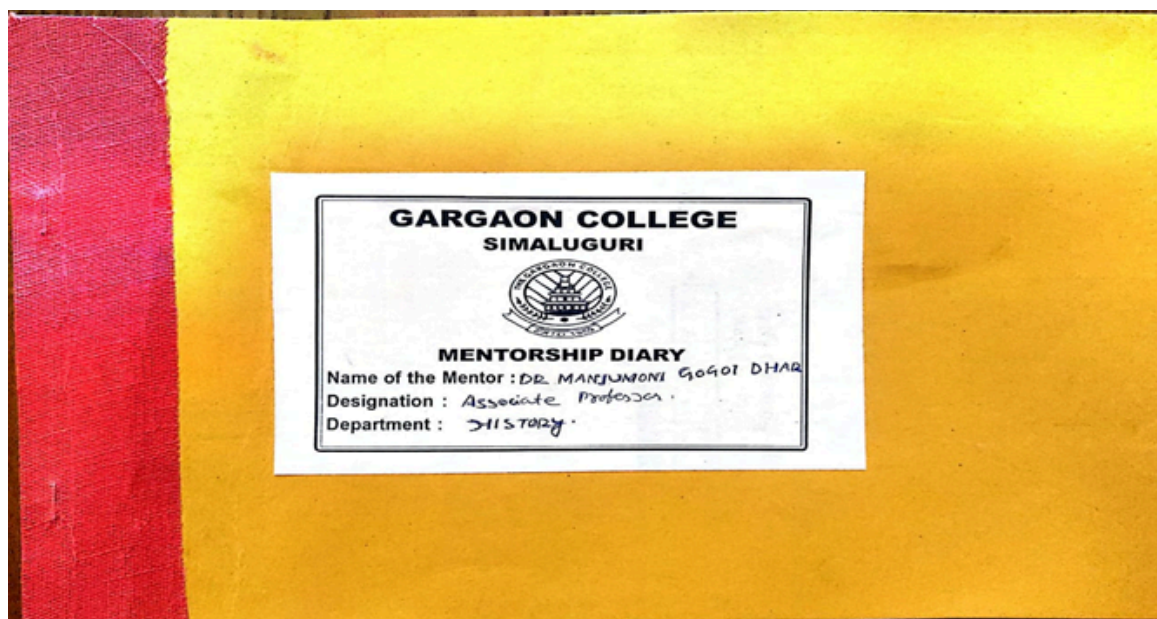
