


## SWACHHTA CAMPAIGN






## SACHIN PATOR MEMORIAL WOMEN'S INTER-COLLEGE BADMINTON TOURNAMENT





He further described about the adverse effects of child labor such as deprivation to education, health and safety issues, negative economic effects, social and moral responsibilities etc. In his speech he defined about the scenario of child labor in India and across the world. At the end he emphasized on the initiatives adopted by United Nations (UN) for combating child labor across the globe. He further added the legislations involved in Indian constitution for combating child labor and the penalties associated with the offence of child labor. The programme was attended by 49 participants which included students and faculty members.

The program aims to inspire a global movement against child labour with the slogan "Social Justice for All. End Child Labour!" in 2023. Its purpose is to draw attention to the issue of child labour and mobilize efforts to combat it effectively. The continued observance of this day reflects the commitment of various stakeholders to address this pressing issue and work towards a world free from child labour.





## Anti-Child Labour Day observed

**TINSUKIA June 13:** As a part of week-long campaign against injustice to women and child, the Centre for Development Initiatives (CDI) organized Anti-Child Labour Day in sync with observance of World Day against Child Labour on Monday in accordance with the theme "Social Justice for all-End Child Labour".

The CDI organized a rally at Hijraguri Tinsukia involving children from locality as well in students from Assamese school and Prabhati English School which culminated at Holy Child School

where Satyan Narayan Boruah District Child Protection Unit (DCPU) addressed the gathering in presence of school's principal and Sisters of Charity. He spoke on the need for provision of quality education to prevent children under 14 years of age from becoming a child labourer. The students were made aware on the importance of observing the Anti-Child Labour Day all over the world. A total of 51 students took part in the rally.

He further talked about the scenario of child labour in India and across the world, emphasizing on the initiatives adopted by United Nations (UN) for combating child labour across the globe. Moreover, he spoke about the legislations involved in Indian constitution for combating child labour and the penalties associated with the offence of child labour.
